

## Custom Native Grass Mixture Requirements



- Grass mix should include 80% or more of the following species that are the predominant native grasses in El Paso County. This list comes from the Reference Plant Community of Major Land Resource Area (MLRA) 49, Southern Rocky Mountain Foothills and MLRA 69, Upper Arkansas Valley Rolling Plans.
  - Western wheatgrass
  - Blue grama
  - Green needle
  - Big bluestem
  - Mountain muhly
  - Little bluestem

- Needle and thread
- Sideoats grama
- Buffalograss
- Switchgrass
- Galleta
- Akali sacaton
- 2. The remaining 20% should be species native to Colorado according to the USDA Plants

  Database (plants.usda.gov)
- 3. Smooth brome and crested wheatgrass are not allowed.
- 4. Up to 10% of a sterile cover crop may be included for quick germination and soil stabilization. Recommended sterile cover crops include Quickguard triticale, sterile white oat, Proso millet.
