Residential rates apply to service for general residential purposes, including multi-family dwelling units within a single structure and under one ownership, provided that the main use is attributable to the primary dwelling unit.

Discontinuance of Service Due to Nonpayment

TOD Option, On-Peak and Off-Peak Period Definitions

- On-Peak periods: Winter, Oct through May, 4 p.m. to 8 p.m., Mon through Fri
- On-Peak periods: Summer, Jun through Sept, 4 p.m. to 8 p.m., Mon through Fri
- Off-Peak periods: All other hours plus legally observed holidays
