

# Water Allocation Plan Required Site Information

Business customers, multi-family customers and single-family residential customers with lots 20,000 square feet or larger are required to submit site information with their water allocation plan application.

Site information is not required for single-family residential customers with lots smaller than 20,000 square feet. If unknown, lot size can be found using the El Paso County Assessor Parcel Search Tool at <https://assessor.elpasoco.com/>.

### What information do I need to submit?

- A list of all water account numbers used for outdoor watering.
- A site map, like the one shown on this page, identifying actively irrigated landscaped areas and size of the area. Any landscaped area that is watered with sprinklers once a month is considered actively irrigated.
- Applicants applying on a customer's behalf (not directly employed by the customer) will need to submit a consent form completed by the water customer.

### How to create a successful site map?

1. Identify actively irrigated areas on your map.
2. List total actively irrigated area. For example:  
15,230 square feet
3. List areas by plant type, if known. For example:  
Cool-season grass: 10,350 sq. ft.  
Planting beds: 4,880 sq. ft.
